

Tribal Council Resolution 2022-<u>0</u> Funding for IGAP Seasonal Positions

- WHEREAS, Skagway Village (dba Skagway Traditional Council) is the federally recognized Tribal government for all enrolled Tribal citizens in Skagway, Alaska; and
- WHEREAS, Skagway Traditional Council is responsible for the health, safety, welfare and cultural preservation of its Tribal citizens and use of the Skagway Traditional Council's traditional territory; and
- WHEREAS, Skagway Traditional Council's traditional territory reflects all lands and waters historically and presently occupied and utilized by the Skagway Native people since time immemorial, and land within the modern-day community of Skagway is identified in STC Constitutions, Article II Section I; and
- WHEREAS, Article IX Ection 3(g) of the Constitution of STC specifically directs the STC Tribal Council "to protect and preserve Tribal property, wildlife, and natural resources of importance to the Tribe;" and
- WHEREAS, STC has a need that cannot be filled with IGAP funds for seasonal workers; and
- WHEREAS, STC recognizes the importance of creating employment during turmoil years.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council members of Skagway Village here approve to commit unrestricted funds to assist with the IGAP seasonal position up to \$12,000.
