

Tribal Council Resolution 2022-13

Tribal Council Stipend Rate

- Whereas, Skagway Village (dba Skagway Traditional Council) is the federally recognized tribal government for all enrolled tribal citizens in Skagway, Alaska; and
- Whereas, Skagway Traditional Council is responsible for the health, safety, welfare and Cultural preservation of its tribal citizens and use of the Skagway Traditional Council's traditional territory; and
- Whereas, Skagway Traditional Council's traditional territory reflects all lands and waters historically and presently occupied and utilized by the Skagway Native people since immemorial, and land within the modern-day community of Skagway as identified in STC Constitutions, Article II Section 1; and
- Whereas, Article IX Section 3(g) of the Constitution of STC specifically directs the STC Tribal Council "to protect and preserve Tribal property, wildlife, and natural resources of importance to the Tribe;" and
- Whereas, STC tribal council recognizes that tribal council stipend has not been updated in possibly over ten plus years: and,
- Whereas, the tribal council would like to recognize and compensate all council members from taking time out of their day to attend meetings or research and read materials to prepare for meetings.
- **Now therefore, be it resolved,** the tribal council approves to increase tribal council stipend rate for all council members to \$150 per meeting and \$200 per meeting for the council president effective First fiscal quarter of FY2023 starting on 10.1.2022.
