### Authorization and Support for Joining the

## Southeast Alaska Tribal Ocean Research (SEATOR) Consortium

- **WHEREAS,** the Skagway Traditional Council (STC) is the governing body of the Skagway Village, a federally recognized Tribe; and
- **WHEREAS,** the importance of using both traditional ecological knowledge and science to ensure Tribal lands, water, and cultural resources are protected and accessible for future generations; and
- WHEREAS, the negative effects of environmental contaminants and climate change can impact Tribal citizens' ability to sustainable access traditional and subsistence resources; and
- whereas, the ability to collaborate with other SEATOR partner Tribal governments will help to ensure a unified effort in providing consistent quality environmental data, educational outreach materials, and the ability to leverage further funding; and
- **WHEREAS,** the developed consortium will collaborate and work with State, Federal and university groups to ensure Tribal needs are being met.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Skagway Traditional Council does hereby support the Southeast Alaska Tribal Ocean Research consortium and would like to collaborate and be an active member of SEATOR; utilizing EPA IGAP funds to perform work associated with SEATOR project goals.
